

Conference welcomes new resource supporting data protection in humanitarian action

John Edwards, Chair of the International Conference of Data Protection and Privacy Commissioners, today welcomed the publication of the *Handbook on Data Protection in Humanitarian Action* by the Brussels Privacy Hub, an academic research centre of the Vrije Universiteit Brussel (Free University of Brussels or VUB) in Brussels, Belgium, and the Data Protection Office of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) in Geneva, Switzerland.

"I congratulate the authors and institutions that have worked so hard to produce such a substantial resource and for their generosity in making it free to download" Mr Edwards said.

"The 37<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Data Protection Commissioners adopted a <u>Resolution on Privacy and International Humanitarian Action</u> at its meeting in Amsterdam in 2015 that acknowledged the importance of international humanitarian action and recognised the integral role of good information handling practices in this area."
