### OPENING CEREMONY

- IFAI's President Commissioner, Ph.D. Jacqueline Peschard, chaired the session.
- Mrs. Peschard pronounced a welcoming speech.
- The agenda and its working points were revised.
- Agenda was read by the President Commissioner, Jacqueline Peschard.

### REPORT PRESENTATIONS

- The floor was handed over to Spain, which presented the Credentials Committee Report and the accreditation resolution.
- Presentation of new accreditations was made by the Credentials Committee:
  - **Presentation of the Report of the Credentials Committee.**
  - **Accreditation Resolution.**
- The floor was given to Canada to present the **Report of the Interim Executive Committee to Address the Organisational Set up of the Conference and the approval of the "Rules and Procedures"**.
  - Chair of the Committee: Canada (Commissioner Jennifer Stoddart).
  - Committee members: Canada, France, Germany, Israel, Mexico and Spain.

### RESOLUTION PRESENTATIONS

- Resolutions submitted to this 33<sup>rd</sup> ICDPPC were considered in order of reception.
- The floor was given to New Zealand.
  - **Resolution on Data Protection and Major Natural Disasters** was presented by New Zealand's Privacy Commissioner, Marie Shroff.
- The floor was opened to discussion and approval of the resolution.
- The floor was given to the Authorities of the United Kingdom and Canada.
  - Authorities of the United Kingdom and Canada were invited to introduce their proposals for resolutions.

- ***Resolution on Privacy Enforcement Coordination at the International Level*** was presented by the Information Commissioner of the United Kingdom, Mr. Christopher Graham, and Canada's Privacy Commissioner, Jennifer Stoddart.
- The floor was opened to discussion and approval of the resolution.
- The participants were invited to have a coffee break.
- The floor was given to the Federal Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of Germany, Mr. Peter Schaar.
  - ***Resolution on the Use of Unique Identifiers in the Deployment of Internet Protocol Version 6 (IPv6)*** was presented by Germany.
- The floor was open to discussion and approval of the resolution.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS

- It was time for the presentation of the committee reports and working groups of the 33<sup>rd</sup> International Conference of Data Protection and Privacy Commissioners.
- The New Zealand Commissioner, Marie Shroff, was invited to introduce the ***Steering Group on Representation before International Organizations***.
- The floor was given to New Zealand.
- The President of the National Commission of Information and Liberties, Ms. Isabelle Falque-Pierrotin, was invited to present the report on the ***Promotion of the International Standards: State of Play***.
- The floor was given to France.
- The Representant of the APEC Data Privacy Sub-Group ("DPS") was invited to present the ***Observer Report from the APEC Data Privacy Sub-Group ("DPS") Meeting***.
- The floor was given to the Observer.
- The Report of the advancement on the resolutions introduced during the 32<sup>nd</sup> International Conference; was invited to be introduced, particularly, the ***report on the state of privacy by design*** was introduced by Canada, Ms. Ann Cavoukian.
- The floor was given to the ensuing block.

### INSTALLATION OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND WORKING GROUPS

- The installation of the Executive Committee and Working Groups were announced.
- The Executive Committee would consist of three permanent members, and the host of the last International Conference (Mexico - IFAI) and the host of the next International Conference (Uruguay - AGESIC).
- The new Committee was confirmed to exist of the DPAs of: Netherlands, United States, Australia, Uruguay and Mexico.
- The Executive Committee would take over the roles of the current.

- **Steering Committee:** Promotes the ICDPPC in International Organizations. Coordinates: New Zealand.
- **Credentials Committee:** Prepares accreditations before the Conference. Coordinates: Ireland, Hong Kong, and Spain.
- **Interim Executive Committee:** Executes according to the resolution on “Organisational Set Up” approved in Jerusalem. The Secretariat of this group is held by Canada.
- **Promotion Group of International Standards on the Protection of Privacy with regard to the processing of Personal Data:** Coordinated by Spain and Israel through having received the mandate in Jerusalem, at the framework of the resolution of standards promotion and the celebration of an international conference on a binding judicial mechanism.
- Working Groups of the International Conference:
  - International Working Group on Data Protection in Telecommunications.
  - Working Group on Privacy Enforcement Coordination at the International Level
- The nomination for country candidacies was announced in order to host the next 34<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Data Protection and Privacy Commissioners in 2012.
- Candidacies were submitted to discussion. Uruguay was choice to host the edition number 34.
- General topics and next host country were announced.
- Mexico City Declaration was read.
